Internships for Mental Health Counseling and Social Work Master's Programs

Diversus Health is currently accepting interns from Master's of Counseling, Master's of Psychology, and Master's of Social Work programs. Most internships are through the Adult Outpatient Network. We are open to both traditional and non-traditional academic calendars, with most students starting in August/September but some joining at other times of year based on capacity. Interns are required to commit to a minimum of 500 (social work) or 600 hours (counseling/psychology) for the internship experience and are expected to be on site 16–20 hours per week over an 8–9 month period.
